- This is an official ADGA show. ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN. Base date for computing age shall be day shown. No pre-show milkout. The original registration/recordation certificate must be shown to the show secretary or his/her agent prior to the animal being shown. Stamped duplicates may be used for animals less than six months old.
- The barns will be ready Friday night, June 5 **AFTER** 5 PM. 1st Straw bedding will be provided for the 6 x 6 pens. No hay or grain will be available for purchase at the fairgrounds. There are feed stores close to the fairgrounds. Please plan to leave the fairgrounds by **2 hours after the last class** for pen tear-down.
- Animals showing signs of contagious diseases such as soremouth or ringworm, or having hairless, ripe or open abscesses will not be allowed in the barn or show ring. Entry fees will not be refunded on these animals. Please be courteous to your fellow breeders and leave unhealthy animals at home.
- Class ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place. 1st and 2nd place udders will be selected by the judge in each milking class. Special awards and/or rosettes will be given to Senior and Reserve Champion Doe, Best of Breed, Best Udder of Breed, and Best Udder in Show. Best Senior Doe in Show prize will be \$50.
- Entry fee is \$5.00 per animal per show. Entries must be received by Wednesday, June 3, 2009 or will be considered late. Entry fee at the show is \$6.00 per animal per show. Substitutions will be allowed. No refunds. Pen fees are \$10.00 per 6 x 6 pen. 1st bedding is included. Pen space is limited, so please sign up for pens when you enter.
- Youth fitting and showing is Sunday, June 7 at 8AM. Entry fee is \$3.00 per youth. Youth will show in the following classes: Novice (Grades 4 -12, 1st time competing in showmanship), Pre-4H (3rd grade and younger), Junior (Grades 4-6), Intermediate (Grades 7-9) and Senior (Grades 10-12).
- Bring chairs for seating around the show rings and the pens.
- There is no guaranteed food service on the fairgrounds. Bring your own meals or plan on going off the grounds to one of the many nearby restaurants.
- Raffle – a wonderful raffle of goat and people related items will be held during the show. Donations will gladly be accepted at the show. Bring your spare change to try your luck and help support the show.

Specialty Class Definitions

Jr Get of Sire	Three does, never freshened, sired by the same buck
Best Three Jr Does	Three dry does bred and owned by exhibitor
Sr Get of Sire	Three does, at least one in milk, sired by the same buck
Produce of Dam	Two does, at least one in milk, produced by the same dam
Dam and Daughter	Dam and her daughter, both in milk
Best Three Does	Three does, at least one in milk, bred and owned by exhibitor
Dairy Herd:	Four milking does owned by exhibitor
